<u>Alarmed</u> at the fast increasing number of Muslims sent to Xinjing into camps without trials and the Chinese government's inability to admit these are internment camps.

Facing the Evidence of satellite images taken on April 22, 2018 of massive compounds divided into segments with large towers, similar to a working camp/facility, surrounding XinJiang.

<u>Intermittent</u> at the vast reports of Uyghur and Kazakh Muslims speaking out about the various torture methods used in these "vocational schools" against "terrorism and religious extremism" such as electric shock therapy, sterilization, intensive interrogation sessions, beatings, and other methods of physical pain.

Recognizing the widespread media that create fear against Muslims and having propagandise that Muslims will lead to anarchy and terrorism within a nation.

Asserting The United Nations will not tolerate the genocide of the Muslim ethnic groups based on the ignorance that all Muslims will create international terrorism, and will react with harsh sanctions.

Bearing in mind the difference in belief systems of the Muslims in China and its government,

- 1. <u>Commend</u> the ending of all propaganda that report the internment camps are education schools to prepare the impoverished for jobs.
- 2. Requests that the camps killing off Muslims are shut down while this is basic freedom of religion despite the President Xi Jinping's terrorism-based fear.
- 3. Encourages other countries to place sanctions on China to prevent the promotion of lack of freedom to self-expression and religion.
- 4. <u>Urges</u> soldiers to be sent on mission to shut down camps, rescue those caught in these camps, and help to relocate broken families.
