Topic: Reforming inhumane prison practices

Reminding nations of the *Universal Declaration of Human Rights* that was ratified on 10

December 1948,

<u>Reaffirming</u> the General Assembly resolution 45/111 of 14 December 1990, which outlined the basic treatment of prisoners;

Noting that the United Nations has declared a global prison crisis, due to the poor prison conditions;

<u>Aware</u> that there are many delegations that are involved in this crisis and require aid to carry out a reform;

<u>Keeping in mind</u> that the problem includes private and federal prisons;

Recognizing that prisoners have human rights;

<u>Deplores</u> the prison practices that have been established due to factors such as overcrowding;

Stressing a need for a universal effort to promote and enforce reformations of prison systems;

<u>Calls</u> for a proactive plan that collectively addresses and resolves the current prison crisis;

Endorses placing sanctions on prisons that do not follow the agreed upon regulations;

Endorses a program to deter crimein the future;

<u>Urges</u> all nations to actively enforce the approved plan;

<u>Requests</u> nations to provide financial aid to other countries and allies who are unable to carry out the reform by themselves.
