Topic: Paris Agreement and Climate Control

Special Political Committee,

<u>Deeply concerned</u> by the current and rising temperature of the planet and emissions of greenhouse gases and other harmful pollutants,

<u>Alarmed by</u> the fact that the average global temperature on Earth has increased by about 0.8° Celsius and the effects this has on the planet,

Recognizing the attempts by the Paris Agreement to reduce and regulate climate control and the high amount of greenhouse gas emissions that are being produced by many nations,

- 1. <u>Encourages</u> all nations to undertake ambitious efforts to combat climate change and adapt to its effects;
- 2.<u>Urges</u> all nations to comply with the goals of the Paris Agreement to promote climate control for the welfare of the planet;
- 3. <u>Requests</u> all nations to divest from the use of fossil fuels, cut emissions of methane, invest in more eco-friendly means of transportation and invest in renewable energy sources;
- 4. <u>Authorizes</u> a price increase of carbon by 10% and place a 5% tax on all purchases of carbon to invest into more eco-friendly methods of consumptions;
- 5. <u>Calls upon</u> all nations to agree upon a regulated amount of greenhouse gas emissions a country can produce every three months;
- 6. <u>Proclaims</u> a mandatory fine on all nations that produce a level of greenhouse gas emission above the agreed amount in the three month period;
- 7. <u>Further proclaims</u> that the fine be fixed according to how much emissions a country produced over the regulated amount;
- 8.<u>Invites</u> the creation of an organization called the P.E.A.R.S (Pollution Environmental Association for the Reduction of Smokes) to control and regulated the fines and conditions of this resolution.
