Topic: "Giving Greater freedoms to the people of the Kurdistan Region"

Reminding nations about the long history of Kurdistan and how the people of the region started self-rule of themselves in the 10th century,

Welcoming the United States' position that Kurdistan should eventually become a nation by 2030,

<u>Keeping in mind</u> that the U.N. gave a nation to the Jewish people by giving them the nation of Isreal,

<u>Alarmed by rising tensions in the region of Kurdistan that is part of Turkey, and the rising tensions between nations in Iran,</u>

Bearing in mind that Iraq has given some level of independence to the people of Kurdistan,

- 1. Express approval of Kurdistan's claim of independence as they have claimed the area as there land back in the 10th century as Shaddadids;
- 2. <u>Takes note of</u> the United States' decision to try to gain independence for the Kurds in Iraq following the First Gulf War;
- 3. Notes that the U.N. in the past decided to give a nation for Jewish people in Isreal. The Kurds are a people without a home who are oppressed in the nations that they are forced to live in;
- 4. Expresses hope that the Kurdish people can be given a home sooner rather than later as violence has arisen between the Kurdish people and the country of Turkey;
- 5. Reaffirms the decision of Iraq to give some level of independence to the Kurdish people by removing troops from disputed areas, and hope that other nations will follow in its footsteps of giving independence.
