The General Assembly,

Alarmed by the recent tensions between the nation of Iran, and the United States of America,

<u>Concerned</u> over recent developments in which the US assassinated the head of the QUDS force, General Solemani, and in response, the nation of Iran attacked US military sites,

<u>Alarmed</u> by the fact that in a turn of events, by order of the United States of America, soldiers are being sent into the middle eastern region as a result, in which could lead to more tension,

Henceforth proposes the following:

- 1. Establishes "The Committee of Tension Relief (CTR)" which would consist of a representative of each UN member nation, along with the USA and Iran;
  - This committee would meet at a common ground for diplomatic discussion in efforts to decrease tension,
  - This committee would act as an outlet for all nations to discuss the ongoing situation between the USa and Iran,
  - The aforementioned committee would be tasked with coming up with a peace treaty as long as it's agreeable upon the United States of America, and Iran and should aim to relieve tension between both nations, and to foster better relations between the latter nations,
- 2. Orders the deployment of peacekeeping forces to be stationed in the United States of America, and Iran to act as a medium of diplomacy, and stability, and to keep the peace by preventing any further acts of violence against each other;
- 3. Hoping to ensure that the world remains in a peaceful state.
