***Five Points Bakery** 44 Brayton St, Buffalo, NY 14213

In Buffalo's lower west side, Five Points Bakery strives to make whole grain bread sourcing items from local farms like their wheat, honey, milk, eggs and a host of other local goods. The bakery believes that everything deserves respect, from farmers to people, buildings, neighborhoods and ways of life. Their goal is to have something that will bring joy to each individual customer and bring together the community.

United Way of Buffalo & Erie County 742 Delaware Ave, Buffalo, NY 14209

Since 1917, the United Way has worked to enhance the health, financial stability, and education of every person in our community. They bring people, organizations and resources together to create systemic community change through collaborative leadership.

Jewish Family Services of WNY 70 Barker St, Buffalo, NY 14209

JFS helps refugees to build new lives of safety and dignity as members of our community. JFS helps refugees and immigrants to become economically, socially and civically integrated in our community. JFS' staff members, many of whom are former refugees themselves, provide compassionate and culturally appropriate services to these newcomers.

International Institute of Buffalo 864 Delaware Ave, Buffalo, NY 14209

The Institute offers refugee resettlement and employment programs; provides services to survivors of domestic violence and human trafficking; offers translation and interpretation services to break down barriers; presents global education programs for students, adults and businesses; and hosts international visitors.

***West Side Bazaar** 25 Grant St, Buffalo, NY 14213

An international market and food destination, the West Side Bazaar (WSB), provides entrepreneurs an incubator space to build a business from a seed to a full grown plant in a safe, nurturing and inexpensive environment. Facilitated by the Westminster Economic Development Initiative (WEDI), WSB offers customers a diverse and unique experience of flavors and crafts.

***Hope Refugee Drop-In Center** 248 W Ferry St, Buffalo, NY 14213

This organization provides tools for self-empowerment to refugees and immigrants who now call Buffalo home. Operated by Jericho Road Community Health Center, the Drop-In Center provides non-traditional case management with a participatory development model in which clients identify their own needs and Hope helps provide a path to meet those needs.

***Catholic Charities** 20 Herkimer St, Buffalo, NY 14213

Providing essential services to immigrants and newcomers to this country, CCUSA advocates for policies that protect family unity and allow newcomers an opportunity to contribute and participate more fully in our communities.

***Jericho Road Community Health Center** 184 Barton St, Buffalo, NY 14213

Providing wholistic healthcare for the underserved and marginalized communities in Buffalo and across the world, Jericho Road is an core service for our refugee population. Their vision is for underserved and marginalized individuals, families, and communities in Buffalo and across the world to become healthy and whole.

***Stitch Buffalo** 1215 Niagara St, Buffalo, NY 14213

Stitch Buffalo is an inclusive space for Refugee and Immigrant women to create handcrafted goods and find economic empowerment; a textile art center for community members to gain and share skills in the textile arts; and an organization committed to stewarding the environment through the re-use of textile supplies.

Journey's End Refugee Services Inc. (not on the route) 2495 Main St #530, Buffalo, NY 14214

A Christian community-based organization, Journey's End's mission is welcoming refugees without regard to ethnic origin or creed and to assist them to become healthy, independent, contributing members of the community.
